

**CITY OF LEEDS**  
**Minutes**  
**Special Meeting**  
**June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2013**

A special meeting of the Leeds City Council was called to order by Mayor Lloyd Himle at 6:15 on June 20, 2013. Present were councilmen: Kyle Nelsen, Linda Himle and Terry Westphal. Councilman Pete Ritterman was absent. Also present were City employees Edythe Nelsen, Kari Follman and Justin Nelsen.

Nelsen made a motion, seconded by Himle, to table trading in skid steer until more information and additional quotes can be obtained. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Westphal that purchase of a Brushcat mower attachment will be contingent on if we purchase a tracked skid steer. Motion was seconded by Linda Himle. Kyle Nelsen abstained. Voting yea were Westphal and Linda Himle. The motion carried.

Linda Himle made a motion, seconded by Nelsen, to trade in our current John Deere Tractor on a Hustler mower from Napa in Devils Lake. Westphal abstained. Voting yea were Nelsen and Linda Himle. The motion carried.

Justin Nelsen is to obtain more information on the recent fence that was erected around the City's pump house at Pleasant Lake.

Nelsen made a motion to accept correcting grammatical error to Chapter 7 of the Leeds City Ordinances. Making additional changes was tabled to allow time for research. The motion was seconded by Westphal. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Nelsen, seconded by Linda Himle, to discontinue services to WSG account # 266 due to delinquent account. The curb stop is to be replaced, at property owner's expense, if it is inoperable. The motion carried.

A motion to adjourn was made by Linda Himle, seconded by Westphal. The meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm.
